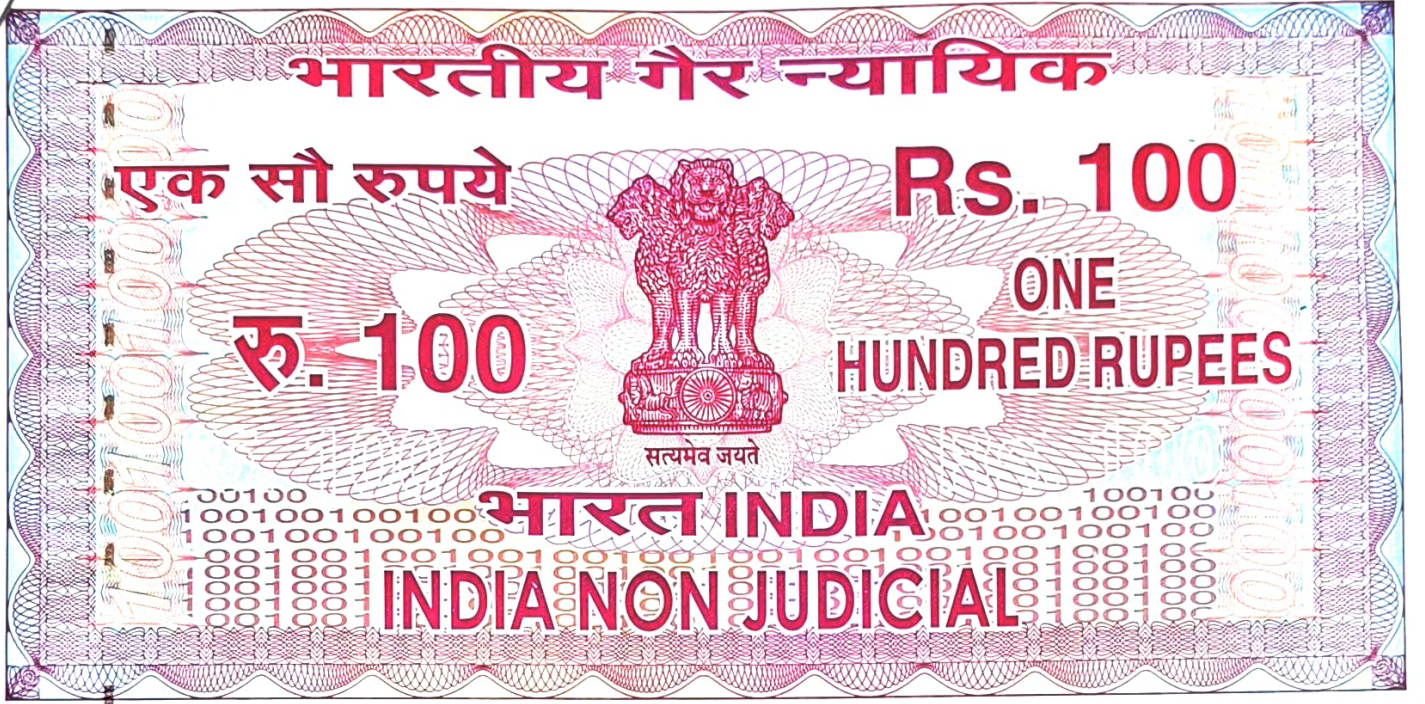

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)- I

Between

Scott Christian Higher Secondary School

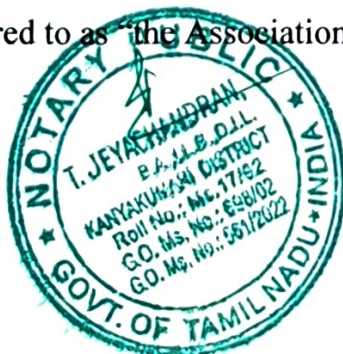
(Hereinafter referred to as "the School")

AND

Scott Christian Higher Secondary School Alumni Association

(Reg. No. 33/25)

(Hereinafter referred to as "the Association")



1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into for the purpose of ensuring that the School Van purchased through the funds contributed by the Association shall be utilized exclusively for the welfare and benefit of the students of the School and safeguarded from misuse or unauthorized utilization.

2. Ownership and Registration

- a) The Van shall be registered in the name of the School in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations of the Government of Tamil Nadu.
- b) The entire purchase cost of the Van shall be borne by the Association.
- c) The Van shall permanently display the following inscription in a visible manner:
“Donated by Scott Christian Higher Secondary School Alumni Association – For Student Use Only.”

3. Usage of the Van

- a) The Van shall be used solely for transportation of students and staff for academic, educational, cultural, sports, and other official School-related activities with the knowledge and approval of the School Management and the Association.
- b) The Van shall not be used for any personal, private, political, commercial, or unauthorized purposes.

4. Control and Monitoring

- a) A “Van Oversight Committee” shall be constituted consisting of:

One representative from the Association

One representative from the School Management

One representative from the Parent-Teachers Association (PTA)

- b) The Committee shall supervise and monitor:

Maintenance of trip and fuel logbooks

Periodical maintenance schedules

Driver appointment, conduct, and discipline

Proper and authorized utilization of the Van



5. Financial Responsibility

- a) All recurring and operational expenses including fuel charges, driver salary, maintenance, insurance, permit fees, taxes, and statutory expenses shall be borne by the School.
- b) In the event the Van is purchased through a partly or 50% loan arrangement, the Equated Monthly Installments (EMI) shall be paid by the School until full closure of the loan.
- c) Any extraordinary expenditure arising out of accident repairs, major mechanical replacement, or unforeseen damages may be financially supported by the Association subject to approval by its Executive Committee. In the absence of such approval, the responsibility shall rest with the School.

6. Misuse and Safeguards

- a) In the event of misuse or violation of the terms of this Agreement, the Association shall have the right to:

Issue a written notice to the School seeking corrective measures; and/or

Recommend temporary suspension of the usage of the Van until such corrective measures are implemented.

- b) In the event of repeated or serious misuse, the Association reserves the right to seek repossession or appropriate legal remedy through due process of law.

7. Transfer, Sale, or Encumbrance

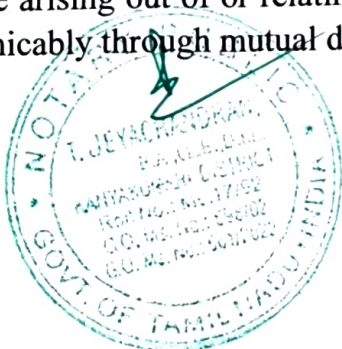
The School shall not sell, mortgage, lease, transfer, pledge, or otherwise create any encumbrance over the Van without obtaining prior written consent from the Association.

8. Duration of Agreement

This Agreement shall remain valid and enforceable for the entire operational life of the Van or until mutually terminated in writing by both parties.

9. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall, in the first instance, be resolved amicably through mutual discussion between the parties.



If the dispute remains unresolved, the matter shall be referred to a mutually agreed sole arbitrator at Nagercoil/ court of law and the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties.

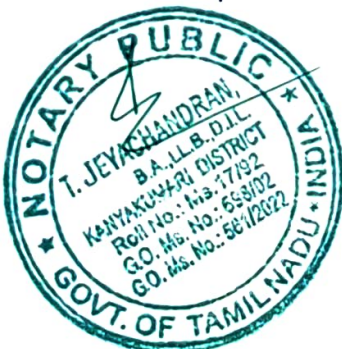
